Turner Pointe is a joint venture between The Trenton Housing Authority and Conifer Realty, LLC. Turner Pointe is comprised of several three-story townhome buildings (like the one pictured at left), housing a total of 77 new apartment units.

During the ribbon-cutting ceremony, THA Chair Clifton Anderson presented a proclamation to NJ State Sen. Shirley K. Turner (THA Commissioner Darlene Weldon is standing behind Anderson). The Turner Pointe community is named in honor of Sen. Turner.

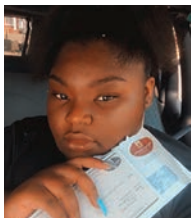
Jamira Bennett
